## The French Connection

A workshop for singers directed by **Ghislaine Morgan**

Ghislaine Morgan is in much demand internationally as a workshop leader, choral coach, and singing teacher. As a soprano, for 20 years she performed with vocal ensembles such as The Monteverdi Choir, The Tallis Scholars, The Sixteen and the King's Consort, She presently works with choral scholars at Cambridge University, and teaches in London and Amsterdam.

In this workshop we shall explore a variety of sacred and secular music by French and Franco-Flemish composers. Works we shall sing during the day are likely to include Passerau's *Il est bel et bon; La, la je ne l'ose dire* by Pierre Certon; *Mille Regrets* and *Gaude Virgo, Mater Christi* by Josquin de Prez; Goudimel's *Hodie nobis coelorum rex*; and *O vos omnes* and *Alleluia Surrexit Dominus* by Jaquet of Mantua. During the day Ghislaine will advise on aspects of vocal technique and interpretation.

The Venue: St Andrew's United Reformed Church is in Mount Park Road, between Aston Road and King's Avenue a few minutes' walk from Ealing Broadway station (District & Central Lines and National Rail). Bus routes 65,83, 112, 226, 207, 427, E1, E2, E7, E8, E8, E10 & E11 all stop nearby. For those coming by car the church has a small car park and there is free street parking nearby on Saturday. Coffee & tea will be available from 10 a.m. There are pubs serving food nearby and cafés, restaurants, sandwich bars and small supermarkets around Ealing Broadway.
