We will study a selection of choral works by William Byrd including "O Lord Make Thy Servant Elizabeth ...", "Laudibus in Sanctis", and "Ave Verum Corpus". A feature of the workshop, but not occupying the whole day, will be working back from 21st century scores to parts without barlines.

Jeremy Jackman, for ten years first counter-tenor with The King's Singers, is a vastly experienced professional musician whose work in the field of vocal/choral music is of the highest international standard and now enjoys an enviable reputation as a choral director and choir trainer. With expertise acquired through years of professional performing at the world's most prestigious venues, and an outgoing personality enabling him to establish an instant rapport with choirs and choral groups of all ages, sizes and standards, Jeremy is in increasing demand internationally as a conductor and workshop director.

Applications are invited from chorus singers (SATB). This will be Jeremy's first workshop for TVEMF and you are advised to book early.

St. Sepulchre's is the largest parish church in the City of London, dating back to 1137 but best known today as the National Musicians' Church. It is located at the junction of Holborn Viaduct and Giltspur Street, opposite the Old Bailey. See www.st-sepulchre.org.uk
