Tomás Luis de Victoria (1548-1611) is the greatest Spanish composer of the Renaissance and at this workshop, on the occasion of the 400th year of his death, we will sing his mass setting 'Salve Regina' for double chorus (SSAB / SATB) and also the five part (SSATB) motets 'Ascendens Christus in Altera' and 'Gaude Maria Virgo'.

We are delighted that Eamonn Dougan, a new tutor to TVEMF, will direct the workshop. Eamonn is a highly acclaimed baritone who has performed with many leading British early music vocal ensembles. He has been a member of The Sixteen since 2001 and assistant conductor since 2006.

The day will begin with coffee and registration at 10.00am for a 10.30am start and run till 5.00pm. There are pubs serving lunches in Ickenham and a good café. Ickenham URC is in Swakeleys Road, on the corner of Eleanor Grove. The church is half a mile from Ickenham station (Metropolitan) and about three quarters of a mile from West Ruislip (Chiltern and Central). The Oxford buses stop at Hillingdon Circus about a mile away. For drivers there is parking in the streets by the church.
