## Monteverdi at San Marco - church music of the Venetian years

James Weeks is a composer and conductor. His music is widely performed and broadcast and as well as maintaining a busy freelance conducting schedule, he is the director of the outstanding group EXAUDI and is musical director of the New London Chamber Choir and the Orlando Chamber Choir. He tutors regularly at the Dartington summer music school and at various venues abroad. (www.jamesweeks.org)

In this Monteverdi anniversary year, James wanted to avoid the 1610 Vespers (of which there have been and are still to come numerous excellent performances around the country), hence we will be working on *Dixit Dominus (secondo)*, *Beatus Vir (primo)*, *Laudate Dominum (primo)*, *Adoramus* and *Deus tuorum militum* – most of these are from the *Selva Morale e Spirituale*. With regard to instruments, we will need: violins (could be one-to-a-part), violas, cornetts, sackbuts & appropriate continuo instruments (keyboard, curtal, bass viols, theorbos etc). **Note**: Instrumentalists should be prepared to sing for some of the time to avoid too much doubling of parts.

St Andrew's United Reformed Church is in Mount Park Road, between Aston Road and King's Avenue and is a few minutes walk from Ealing Broadway station (District & Central Lines and National Rail). Bus routes 65,83,112,226,207,427,E1,E2,E7,E8,E8,E10 & E11 all stop nearby. For those coming by car the church has its own small car park but there is plenty of free street parking nearby on Saturday.

Coffee & tea will be available from 10 a.m. and lunch will be from about 1 pm. until 2 pm. There are pubs serving food nearby and there are numerous cafés, restaurants, sandwich bars and small supermarkets around Ealing Broadway which is only a few minutes' walk away.

The fee for the day is £12 for members of TVEMF and other Fora and £14 for non-forum members).
